



Contact Lens Agreement

- Contact lenses are medical devices that need to be fitted by a licensed eye doctor.
- Contact lenses are foreign devices that when placed in the eye can increase your chance of obtaining an eye infection, if recommended guidelines are not followed properly; therefore a contact lens prescription expires in one year from the original exam date and cannot be filled thereafter without another eye exam.
- If you experience any unexplained eye pain, redness, discharge, and/or decrease in vision, the first thing is to remove your contact lenses and call the eye doctor!
- The final contact lens prescription will be determined at your scheduled follow visits.
- All follow-up visits within 60 days are important and complimentary. All follow-ups after 60 days will be charged as an office visit. This excludes any medical problems, which will be billed accordingly.
- The contact lens fitting fee is a non-refundable fee.
